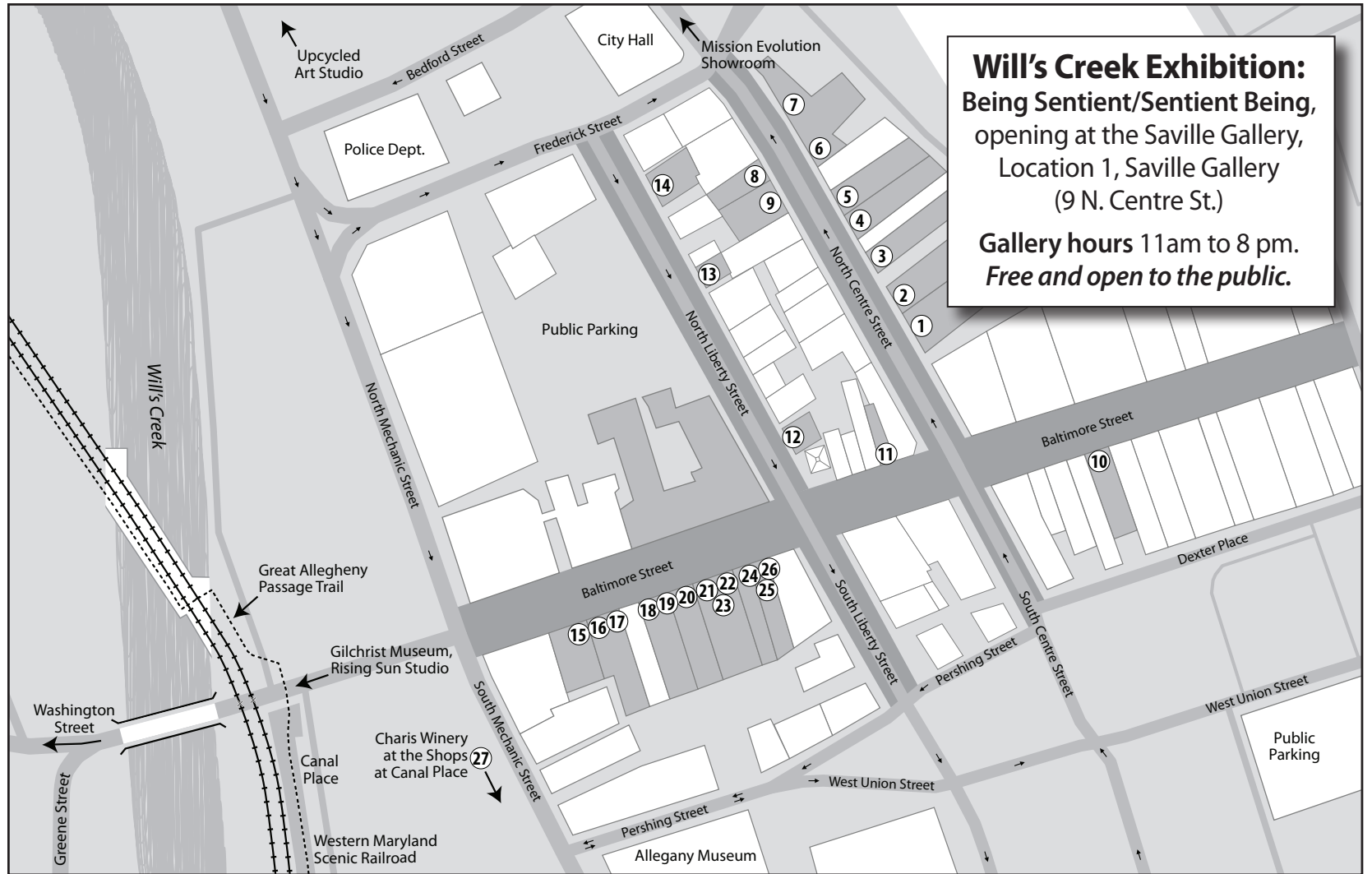

OTHER ARTSY PLACES IN THE GREATER DOWNTOWN AREA

C. William Gilchrist Museum of the Arts (104 Washington St) 1845 mansion houses six renovated galleries, an art library, a costume collection, and landscaped gardens.

Mission Evolution Showroom (302 N. Centre St) Finely handcrafted furniture and woodwork by Arnold d'Epagnier.
